Telephone numbers frequently are changed between issues of the directory, and if one is unable to contact an individual using the number listed in this directory, call No. 600.

Do not guess the number of party being called; consult the directory.

CAUTIONS

Do not force the dial to its resting position, as the satisfactory operation of the telephone system depends upon the correct speed of the dial while returning to the rest position.

INSTRUCTIONS

Dial Tone — This is a steady buzz and is heard after lifting the handset from its cradle and before dialing. It indicates that the phone is ready for use. If this steady buzz is not heard, return the handset to its cradle and after a few seconds try again.

INSTRUCTIONS (Cont'd.)

Silence — When no tone at all is heard upon lifting the handset, it means that the section of the telephone system which controls your own phone is busy. Hang up and try again in a few seconds.

Busy Signal — This is an intermittent buzz. When heard after dialing it means that the number being called is busy. Hang up and try again in a short time.

Wrong Numbers — If your phone repeatedly dials wrong numbers and you have followed correctly the instruction on dialing, your phone probably requires adjustment. Report your number to the Colony Zone Office No. 480. We request the cooperation of all telephone users in this service, because it is the surest and quickest method of locating instruments with defective dials.

Place finger (not pencil or other implements) in the opening over the first digit of the number being called, turn dial to finger stop and then release; wait until Dial Tone stops, then dial the other digits of the number being called in the same manner.

Speak directly into the transmitter with lips close to the mouthpiece. Use ordinary tone of voice and pronounce words clearly and distinctly.

At the end of a conversation return the handset to its cradle. Your line is now immediately ready to make another call. If the handset is not properly replaced in its cradle, both your phone and the other previously called will remain out of service.

Telephone numbers of subscribers on the same party line are the same with the exception of the second digit in the number. To call a subscriber on your own party line:

INSTRUCTIONS (Cont'd.)

1. Dial 9.
2. Dial second digit of your number.
3. Dial second digit of called subscriber's number.
4. Hang up. Both your phone and called subscriber's phone will ring intermittently until one of the two phones is lifted.

Subscribers with 3-digit numbers may call extensions on their own number by the following procedure:

1. Dial 911.
2. Hang up.

All phones on that line will ring continuously until one of the phones is lifted.

To test your telephone, dial your own number. If the busy signal is heard, your line and associated equipment are in proper working order. If the busy signal is not heard, report your phone out of order to the Colony Zone Office No. 480.

Calls to Oranjestad & San Nicolas — can be made only from a Lago telephone having an authorized connection to the Government exchange in San Nicolas.

To make a call to San Nicolas lift handset, await dial tone, and dial "0". After a short interval, dial tone will be heard from the San Nicolas exchange. Dial the number desired in San Nicolas. Number listings of Government telephone subscribers in San Nicolas are available at Lago telephones with connections to the San Nicolas exchange.

To call the attendant at the San Nicolas exchange, first dial "0". When dial tone is heard from San Nicolas, dial "5115".

To make a call to Oranjestad, first dial "0". When dial tone is heard from San Nicolas exchange, dial "5190". This will connect you to the operator at the Oranjestad manual exchange. Ask the operator to make connection to the desired party in Oranjestad.
